This doesn't mean a bag of peanuts and some pork crackling; the food and snack being served should be as premium and lovingly made as the drinks. Small dish dining (a previous trend forecasted by Alliance and available from your sales rep) will penetrate into this new trend.

Consumers are increasingly interested in the flavour profile of various spirits, and are eagar to be more knowledgeable and informed with what they are drinking and what they want cocktails to be made with. As proven with the popularity seen over the past years with the resurgence in gin, this popularity and interest will shift to other spirits and the flavour profiles they offer. Alliance expect rum, vodka and whiskey to be the first to receive their deserved attention, followed by teguila and brandy.

Because of the importance cocktails bring to the on trade industry, included in this trend brochure is a guide to 12 of the most popular cocktails in the UK, and what glass might best be used to serve these.



#### #1 SATAN'S WHISKERS, LONDON

This is not your clichéd swanky London cocktail bar, but Satan's Whiskers is full to the brim with character that oozes from its exposed bricks, taxidermy and hip-hop music.

Like all good restaurants, Satan's Whiskers cocktail menu changes daily, so you're always in for a surprise.

There is also a food menu consisting of bar snacks and veg options, if you're feeling peckish.



#### #4 BRAMBLE, EDINBURGH

Bramble is a gem that is well hidden among the streets of Scotland's capital Edinburgh and is a popular haunt for bartenders, so you know it's going to be good. Bramble, with its understated bare brick walls, leather armchairs and menus bound in old books, came onto the scene in 2006 with a bang, showing the UK what high-end creative cocktails should look like.

The brand also has three other ventures including cocktail events company Mothership, cocktail saloon the Last Word and cocktail bar Lucky Liquor.

#### #18 ORIOLE, LONDON

Disconnect from the hustle and bustle of the outside world in London cocktail bar Oriole, which is refreshingly decorated in an old colonial style with painted murals, African artefacts and deep blue furnishings.

Expect old-school hospitality on your visit, with table service and live music every evening.



#### #19 THE GIBSON, LONDON

Stylish, sophisticated, cool and unique. There's not much more you could want from a cocktail bar other than a great atmosphere, which The Gibson in Old Street has in abundance.

Expect jazz, blues and all kinds of glamour when drinking in The Gibson; perhaps you'll also be served by an old-fashioned flapper girl.

On the menu, you're encouraged to choose a season "you feel like visiting" then select a month and a drink from the month – your option will then "set the co-ordinates of your destination" in history.

There is great skill displayed in the menu, with many of the drinks containing a significant number of ingredients.

#### #24 OPIUM, LONDON

Perhaps this information on the bar's website explains it a little more clearly: "Inspired by the rise of apothecary and the darker side of botany".



#### #36 THE NUTHATCH, MIDDLESBROUGH

The Nuthatch is bringing to the masses of Middlesbrough what should have been brought a long time ago — sophisticated cocktails that have been well thought out and designed for discerning drinkers. Each spirits category is well represented on the cocktail bar's list, with a variety of classic-inspired and new inventions spread throughout the menu.

A recent study by CGA has highlighted that cocktail drinkers visit the on trade 25% more than non-cocktail drinkers. The cocktail market continues to grow in terms of value £587m (+9.5% vs YA) and the number of outlets stocking 41,938.

Influential cocktail drinkers clearly impact the market and understanding their consumer behaviour along with the latest trends, will empower suppliers to better analyse the market and opportunity.

As a result to this growing demand, Alliance have taken it upon ourselves to compile not only the most popular cocktails for the on trade market, but also how to make them, and what we consider to be the most innovative ways to serve them.

### Pornstar Martini

The Pornstar Martini is a real modern classic. It's a cocktail that since its creation in 2002 has found worldwide appreciation. The legendary bartender Douglas Ankrah invented this vodka cocktail behind the bar at The Townhouse Bar in Knightsbridge London. He allegedly initially named the cocktail the 'Maverick Martini' after a dingy club in Cape Town South Africa.

The cocktail quickly gained popularity under the more catchy name of 'Pornstar Martini' which alludes to the passion fruit in the drink. The original order of drinking this crowd favourite is; eat the half a passion fruit, down a shot of decadent champagne or prosecco and then sit back and enjoy the sweet and fruity cocktail.

#### Ingredients:

25ml Passion Fruit Vodka 25ml Vanilla 50ml Passion Fruit Purée 50ml Orange Juice 2 Teaspoons Caster Sugar 1/2 a Passion Fruit to Garnish 25ml Prosecco or Champagne

#### Method:

First, fill a Martini glass with crushed ice to chill and place to one side. Next, in a Boston glass, add in the passion fruit purée and orange juice. Pour in the vanilla and passion fruit vodka then stir.

Fill the Boston glass with cubed ice then place the tin on and shake. Empty your Martini glass and strain in the drink, then garnish with the passion fruit.

Serve with a shot glass of prosecco or champagne on the side.

#### Variation:

Swap the sparkling wine for a different kind of shot. Try a shot of fresh apple cider, a very fruity withier or an IPA served in a tiki or skull shot glass.

### Sex On The Beach

Sex On The Beach is considered a classic cocktail thought to have been created in 1987 in Florida, although there are supposedly a few different origin stories for this fruity & refreshing drink. Made from a vodka, peach schnapps, cranberry juice and either grapefruit juice or orange juice.

#### Ingredients:

9ml Peach Schnapps 35ml Vodka 35ml Orange or Grapefruit Juice

35ml Cranberry Juice

1 Orange slice for Garnish

1 Maraschino cherry for Garnish

#### Method:

Fill your glass with ice to chill. Combine in a mixing glass your peach schnapps, vodka & fruit juices and stir well with a bar spoon. Pour into your now chilled glass, garnish with fruit and enjoy.





### Daiquiri

The original daiquiri is an extremely simple recipe that requires just three common ingredients. It is also one of the freshest drinks you can make and an essential rum cocktail everyone should know and taste.

You'll find that a well-made daiquiri offers a perfect balance of sweet and sour in your glass and this can be adjusted to your personal taste, and easy to develop with new fruit flavours such as watermelon, strawberry or peach.

#### Ingredients:

50ml White Rum 25ml Lime Juice 10ml Sugar Syrup Lime Slice

#### Method:

Shake all the ingredients in your shaker of choice. Once well combined, strain into your glass, garnish with a lime slice and serve.

#### Variations:

- 1.) When experimenting with fruit inclusions, try using frozen fruit pieces in the place of ice, shaking thoroughly to allow the fruits to combine into the drink, then pour without straining.
- 2.) For a more robust flavour substitute golden rum for the white rum.
- Apparently a favourite of Ernest Hemingway while fishing in Havana, a waterside bar named La Terraza made the Daiguiri of the same name. Simply substitute the sugar syrup for blue curaçao.

## Long Island Iced Tea

An absolute classic cocktail, and should be on any bar menu in one form or another. Its origin is still a mystery, is it from 1920's Prohibition resembling an innocent drink in a time when alcoholic drinks were forbidden. Or was this frat house favourite created in the 1970's in Old Beach Inn, a popular bar actually in Long Island?

#### Ingredients:

15ml Triple Sec

15ml Vodka

15ml White or Golden Rum

15ml Gin

15ml Tequila

15ml Fresh Lemon Juice

15ml Fresh Lime Juice

15-30ml Sugar Syrup (depending on taste)

Cola To Top Up

#### Method:

No special requirement here, combine all the spirits, citrus juice and syrup into a shaker can with ice and shake thoroughly. Once combined, strain and pour into a tall glass filled with fresh ice. No garnish is necessary but you can include a wedge of lemon or lime if desired.

### Dry Martini

One of the most complex 2 ingredient cocktails you will ever come across, ratios of gin to vermouth vary greatly, with Alfred Hitchcock once saying he preferred his martini so dry (more gin than vermouth) that "one short glance at a bottle of vermouth" was more than enough for his tastes.

#### Ingredients:

50ml London Dry Gin

10-15ml Dry Vermouth

2 Olives or a Lemon Twist to garnish

#### Method:

Fill a cocktail shaker with ice and add the vermouth. Stir for a few seconds. Strain into a chilled Martini glass. Some prefer to keep the vermouth in, though it can also be used as a wash and then discarded. Add the gin to the ice-filled cocktail shaker and stir briskly for about 50 turns. Strain into the glass. Twist the lemon over the drink, so it's perfumed with the citric oils, and then throw over your shoulder. Serve immediately.

#### Variation

Try incorporating a dash of bitters to the mix. Personal favourites are celery bitters when serving with olives, or orange bitters when served with a lemon twist.



## Espresso Martini

An excellent end to a meal and a drink growing hugely in popularity. The key to a successful espresso martini is to keep your ratios, and use a high quality, ideally freshly ground espresso.

#### Ingredients:

40ml Vodka


20ml Coffee Liqueur

50ml Fresh Espresso

2 or 3 Coffee Beans to garnish

#### Method:

Add ice to a glass to chill and set aside. Combine the vodka, Espresso and coffee liqueur into a shaker with ice, shake vigorously to create the trademark crema foam that sits on top of a Espresso Martini.



# Cocktail Guide – Liquid Lunch

#### The Collins

The first Tom Collins recipe was written by the father of modern cocktail making, Jerry Thomas. It's a simple mix of gin, lemon and sugar syrup, shaken over ice served with soda water, described by the American writer of the 1948 mixologist bible "The Fine Art of Mixing Drinks" as "a lemonade made with charged water and spiked with gin or some other liquor".

Originally just Tom (Gin) and John (vodka) the Collins dynasty has expanded to a number of variations:

Tom Collins - With Old Tom Gin

John Collins – With London Dry Gin

Dutch Collins - With Genever

Captain Collins – With Canadian Whisky

Colonel Collins – With Bourbon Whiskey

Sandy Collins – With Scotch Whisky Mike Collins – With Irish Whiskey

Pedro Collins – With Light White Rum

Pepito Collins – With Tequila


Pierre Collins – With Cognac/Brandy

#### Ingredients:

50ml Gin (or chosen variation spirit) 25ml Lemon Juice 125ml Chilled Soda Water

#### Method:

Build the drink over plenty of ice in a Collins glass, stir gently and garnish with a slice of lemon.



## Whiskey Sour

Spirit, sugar, citrus; the original big three, come together in the Whiskey Sour, whose history stretches back to the Lincoln administration. Few drinks in the cocktail canon are as quick to satisfy and endlessly mutable as the Whiskey Sour. Add a flourish to any component, and you have your own personal spin on the classic. A true Whiskey Sour is thickened with egg white and a few dashes of aromatic bitters for a complementary spice note.

#### Ingredients:

60ml Bourbon (Other whiskey can be used to change the flavour profile) 22ml Lemon Juice

15ml Simple Syrup

15ml Egg White

#### Method:

Combine all ingredients into a shaker with ice and shake vigorously. Strain into a coupe or Double old Fashioned glass and garnish with 3 dashes of Angostura bitters and a orange twist.

#### Sazerac

A close cousin to the Old Fashioned, the Sazerac has been kicking around in one form or another since 1840. In 2008, it was crowned the official cocktail of New Orleans, a designation more suited to marketers than drink mixers. The truth is the Sazerac has always belonged to the Crescent City. Up until the late 1800s, it was made with French brandy as a base—Sazerac de Forge et Fils, to be exact—before bartenders switched to rye, the spirit newly arriving by the barge-load down the Mississippi. A well-made Rye Sazerac is indeed a tasty thing, full of spice and depth, though perhaps, we think, a hair too much muscle.

#### Ingredients:

Absinthe, to Rinse the Glass

- 1 Sugar Cube
- 1/2 tsp Cold Water
- 3 Dashes Peychaud's Bitters
- 2 Dashes Angostura Bitters
- 40ml Rye Whiskey
- 40ml Cognac
